





- ▶ 1962: *Instructions*: the use of UDC is recommended
- ▶ 1988: *Recommendations*: the use of DDC or LCC is recommended
- ▶ 1992: BnF chooses Dewey for open access books
- ▶ 2009: Luminy goes Dewey!
